At Relationships Australia we believe that healthy relationships are essential for the wellbeing of children, families, individuals and communities.

We are committed to social justice and inclusion, and respect the rights of all people, in all their diversity, to live with dignity and safety, and to enjoy healthy relationships.

These principles underpin our work.

Relationships Australia works with you through services tailored to your needs at times of challenge and change in your life. Depending on your needs, services can include counselling, mediation, dispute resolution, relationship education, employee assistance, professional training, community work and early intervention services.



We provide special services to those who are particularly disadvantaged: people living in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities, refugees, those suffering from family violence, substance abuse and other addictions, poor mental health, generational injustice, people who are socially excluded, and those affected by isolation in remote and rural areas of the country.

We provide services from around 200 centres throughout the country, and employ 2,000 staff. We also offer services in an outreach capacity – whether in remote Aboriginal communities, or ‘farm-gate’ services to those in rural areas, or fly-in-fly-out services to mining and other communities. We work with you face-to-face, or by telephone, or on-line, in our centres, or elsewhere.
